

STATEMENT OF EMPLOYMENT OF RELATIVES

A student may work in the same agency with a relative when there is no direct reporting relationship and the relative is not in a position to influence or control the student’s appointment, employment, promotion, or advancement within the agency. A relative is defined as an individual who is one’s aunt, brother, brother-in-law, daughter, daughter-in-law, father, father-in-law, first cousin, grandchild, grandparent, half-brother, half-sister, legal guardian, mother, mother-in-law, nephew, niece, sister, sister-in-law, son, son-in-law, spouse, stepbrother, stepdaughter, stepfather, stepmother, stepsister, stepson, uncle. NIH extends the definition of relative to include close, personal relationships between consenting persons who share the same household.
